# **Purchase Order Flow Down Information**

Quality clauses listed by number in this document are available at <a href="https://www.ftgcorp.com/supplier-terms">https://www.ftgcorp.com/supplier-terms</a> All of the requirements defined under 001 apply to EVERY purchase order. The remaining clauses apply as defined on the purchase order or for the specific material that is supplied and failure to comply will be sufficient cause for rejection. Suppliers that cannot comply with any specific clause are expected to advise FTG Circuits Fredericksburg in writing of the inability to comply.

#### **QUALITY CLAUSES**

- **001 a** Suppliers are preferred to have at least an ISO 9001:2015 registered quality system or documented equivalent. The system must include, at a minimum: requirements for approval of their products, procedures, processes, and equipment, as well as methods of qualifying their personnel to perform to the expected requirements.
  - **b** Supplier must identify the shipped materials with their logo or similar identification, applicable specifications, drawings, and other other technical data used to manufacture and verify the product. This includes inspection and process data.
  - c Supplier must provide a Certificate of Conformance showing evidence of product testing, inspection, and compliance.
  - d Supplier must not ship any non-conforming materials or products without written pre-approval from FTG Circuits Fredericksburg.
  - e Supplier must advise FTG Circuits Fredericksburg Circuits in advance of any product or process changes that affect products shipped to our facility and where required obtain written pre-approval to ship that product.
  - f FTG Circuits Fredericksburg reserves the right access to all supplier sites and facilities on behalf of our own organization, our customers, and regulatory authorities who have a stake in the products we purchase. This includes the right to review all applicable records and documentation associated with the products purchased.
  - g Supplier must provide evidence that all quality clauses and purchase order terms and conditions have been flowed down to their sub-tier suppliers and contractors. This includes clauses from the supplier's system as well as clauses flowed down from FTG Circuits Fredericksburg and its customers.
  - **h** Supplier must package materials in such a way that they are protected from physical damage and the environment. Damage that occurs in transit is the responsibility of the supplier.
  - i Supplier must not charge for boxing, crating, packaging, or cartage unless it is agreed with FTG Circuits Fredericksburg at time of purchase and clearly stated on the Purchase Order.
  - j FTG Circuits Fredericksburg reserves the right to cancel all or part of this order if it is not filled in accordance with the "Conditions of Purchase" and "Quality Clauses" by the due date stated on the front of this Purchase Order.
  - **k** In cases of conflict of any of FTG Circuits Fredericksburg terms with those of the supplier, FTGs terms will govern unless the exception is agreed to in writing by FTG Circuits Fredericksburg.
  - Supplier agrees to indemnify and save harmless FTG Circuits Fredericksburg against any and all claims for patent infringement or for royalties with respect to any goods, apparatus, to be furnished by the Supplier and/or his sub-tier suppliers. The supplier will defend, at its expense, any or all suits or actions at law which may be brought against FTG Circuits Fredericksburg under any such claim for infringements or royalties. FTG Circuits Fredericksburg will give notice in writing if the institution of any such suit or proceeding and will permit the Supplier, through its counsel, to defend the same and will give the supplier all needed information, assistance, and authority to enable it to do so.
  - **m** Acceptance by FTG Circuits Fredericksburg incoming inspection does not absolve suppliers of quality conformance issues found during subsequent processing and/or product testing.
  - r FTG Circuits Fredericksburg expects all suppliers and their sub-contractors not to do business with any persons or companies on the U.S. Dept. of Commerce, Denied Persons List, Dept. of State Debarred Parties List, and Dept. of Treasury, and the Foreign Assets Control Specially Designated Nationals list.
  - Suppliers will adhere to the directions stated in Executive Order 13224, "Executive order on terrorist financing, blocking property and prohibiting transactions with person who commit, threaten to commit, or support terrorism effective 9/24/01 and any subsequent changes.
  - The FTG Circuits Fredericksburg Quality Management System requires that the suppliers retain all manufacturing and quality records for every product shipped to our facility for a minimum of seven years. Exceptions based on customer flow down requirements will be clearly stated on the front of the individual purchase orders when required. If extended retention periods cannot be maintained, storage at FTG Circuits Fredericksburg must be pre-arranged.

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- **q** The supplier shall ensure that its employees are aware of, their contribution to product or service conformity, their contribution to product safety, the importance of ethical behavior.
- r The supplier shall promptly notify FTG Circuits Fredericksburg when non-conforming product has been shipped. The notification of escape (NOE) must be in writing, addressed to the Purchasing Manager and Quality Manager, and submitted within 24 hours of being discovered. Information provided shall include lot number, quantity, original ship date, a description of the non-conformance and containment measure taken to prevent occurrence.
- s Counterfeit Avoidance: As a manufacturer of bare printed circuit boards, FTG Circuits Fredericksburg does not purchase electrical components and therefore, is not subject to the full requirements of AS5553, AS56081 and IDES-STD-1010. Suppliers dealing with both raw materials and components must be in compliance with these stated requirements to ensure an uninterrupted supply of raw materials will always be available to FTG Circuits Fredericksburg and the supplier's ability to do business is not impacted by government or regulatory intervention.
- Raw laminate materials and prepregs must be supplied in accordance with IPC-4101 [latest revision], Specification for Base materials for Rigid and Multilayer Printed Boards.
- Raw laminate material and prepregs must be supplied in accordance with IPC-4103 [latest revision], Specification for Base Materials for High Speed / High Frequency Applications.
- 004 Soldermask must meet the requirements of IPC-SM-840, Qualification and Performance of Permanent Soldermask.
- Supplier must supply Material Safety Data Sheet [MSDS] with this shipment.
- Supplier must supply maximum available shelf life data with this shipment. Products or goods with less than 75% of shelf life remaining must not be shipped, unless agreed to by FTG Circuits Fredericksburg.
- 007 Supplier must provide evidence that the tool or equipment supplied has been calibrated prior to shipment.
- If a FAI is required, supplier must provide samples for evaluation accompanied by an AS9102 first article prior to the shipment of the completed order.
- The applicable specification for this purchase order for copper materials is IPC-4562.
- **010** The applicable specification for this purchase order for silver materials is IPC-4553.
- The applicable specifications for this purchase order for electro-plated nickel gold materials is are: Gold ASTM-B-488 and Nickel SAE-AMS-QQ-N-290.
- The applicable specification for this purchase order for electroless nickel gold materials is IPC-4552.
- The applicable specification for this purchase order for solderable material is J-STD-003.
- Supplier certifies that it will comply with DFAR <u>252.225-7014</u> Alternative 1 if the purchase order contains a U.S. Government Department of Defense [DoD] contract number.
- Supplier certifies that it is aware of and will comply with all other DFAR requirements that may be listed on FTG Circuits Fredericksburg purchase orders and to refuse orders if they cannot comply.
- FTG Circuits Fredericksburg suppliers providing metals in any form must have a copy of the current revision CFSI CMRT (conflict minerals reporting template) on file, including a completed smelter list and make it available to FTG Circuits Fredericksburg on request in accordance with the Dodd-Frank Act, section 1502 (conflict minerals), release 34-63547.
